

## **Complement Distribution Change Guidelines Review Committee for Otolaryngology – Head and Neck Surgery**

The Review Committee for Otolaryngology – Head and Neck Surgery approves complement by year and total. If a program wishes to fill a vacancy in the resident complement, it should be filled at the same level in which the vacancy occurs. Exceptions must be approved by the Review Committee (see [Program Requirement III.B.2.](#)). To submit an exception request, the following information is required:

- Educational rationale for the change in resident complement distribution by year
- Current block diagram
- Proposed block diagram

Once a change in complement distribution is approved, programs are expected to submit a temporary complement increase request at least six months before the off-cycle resident is promoted to the last year of the Otolaryngology – Head and Neck Surgery residency program.
