RE: Nominations for a New Osteopathic Neuromusculoskeletal  
Medicine Review Committee Member

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The Review Committee for Osteopathic Neuromusculoskeletal Medicine is soliciting nominations for a new member position. Self-nominations are encouraged. The term of appointment on the Review Committee will be six years, beginning on July 1, 2027.

The Review Committee will review all nominations received and select a nominee based on the Committee's current needs, professional qualifications, and geographic distribution. It will then send its recommendation for confirmation to the ACGME Board of Directors. In making its selection, the Review Committee will assess each nominee's qualifications according to the following criteria:

- 1. Nominees must have experience as a program director or associate program director of an ACGME-accredited osteopathic neuromusculoskeletal medicine program.**
2. Nominees must have current certification through the American Osteopathic Board of Neuromusculoskeletal Medicine (AOBNMM) or the American Osteopathic Board of Special Proficiency in Osteopathic Manipulative Medicine (AOBSPOMM).
3. Nominees should be actively involved in osteopathic graduate medical education and should demonstrate substantial experience in administration and/or teaching, preferably in an osteopathic neuromusculoskeletal medicine program.
4. Nominees must be able to devote sufficient time to the Review Committee meetings. The Review Committee meets three times per year. The duration of these meetings is typically one to two days, not including travel days, which may include any combination of weekdays and weekends. Members are expected to attend all committee meetings. In addition, new members are expected to attend one meeting prior to their appointment to observe committee activities.

5. Nominees must have sufficient time to devote to pre-meeting Review Committee work. Pre-meeting work may include the review of programs (an estimated four to six hours of work prior to each meeting), participation in subcommittee work (as assigned), and review of meeting documents such as agenda items and related documents.
6. Nominees should be actively involved in osteopathic graduate medical education and should demonstrate substantial experience in administration and/or teaching, preferably in an osteopathic neuromusculoskeletal medicine program.
7. A Review Committee may have two members from the same state, but these members cannot be from the same institution or city/metropolitan area. Accordingly, nominees should not be from the following institutions and areas:
  - AdventHealth Florida – Orlando, Florida
  - Baptist Memorial Medical Education – Southaven, Mississippi
  - Charleston Area Medical Center/Greenbrier Valley Medical Center – Ronceverte, West Virginia
  - MSUCOM Graduate Medical Education Alliance – East Lansing, Michigan
  - Rockville, Maryland
  - Virtua – Stratford, New Jersey
8. Individuals must not be nominated to more than one ACGME Review or Recognition Committee, with an overlapping term.
9. Nominees must be skilled in the use of computers and must have access to the internet and a web camera. Review Committee members are asked to participate in video conference meetings, which are commonly conducted on Zoom. Review Committee members must use electronic systems to access meeting materials, complete program reviews, seek reimbursement of expenses, and many other accreditation-related activities.

### **Review Committee Meeting Dates**

Review Committee meeting dates are established approximately 12 months in advance. Review Committee members are expected to attend all scheduled meetings. The established meeting dates are available on the osteopathic neuromusculoskeletal medicine page of the ACGME website linked above.

### **Nomination Process**

Nominees must complete the Review Committee Member Application and submit a current curriculum vitae. The nominee who is confirmed to become Review Committee member will be asked to sign an agreement with the ACGME and complete an annual disclosure identifying any relationships, positions, or circumstances in which they are involved that may contribute to an actual or apparent conflict or duality of interest.
